

CATTLE MATERIALS PROHIBITED IN ANIMAL FOOD OR FEED TO PREVENT THE TRANSMISSION OF BSE

Prohibited Materials

The following products are considered prohibited materials if they come from cattle, other ruminants or mammals (except for exempted species). Ruminant animals include but are not limited to: cattle, sheep, goats, deer, buffalo, elk.

Bone Meal, steamed	Meat and Bone Meal

Dried Meat Solubles	Meat Meal Tankage
Fleshings Hydrolysate	Meat Protein Isolate
Food Processing Waste	Mechanically Separated Bone
Glandular Meal and Extracted Glandular Meal	Restaurant Food Waste
Hydrolyzed Hair	Salvage Pet Food
Hydrolyzed Leather Meal	Unborn Calf Carcasses

Non-Prohibited or Exempted Materials

The following products, regardless of what species they originated from, are exempt or considered non-prohibited:

Blood and Blood Products	Gelatin
Inspected meat products (such as waste) which have been cooked and offered for human food and further heat processed	Milk Products (Milk and Milk Proteins)

The following non-ruminant products are exempt or considered non-prohibited:

Marine (Fish)	Pure Porcine (Pork) Protein
Poultry	Vegetable
Pure Equine (Horse) Protein	

The following are exempt or considered non-prohibited because they are not protein or tissue, regardless of what species they originated from:

Amino Acids	Grease
Dicalcium phosphate	Oil
Fat ¹	Tallow that contains less than 0.15% insoluble impurities ²

¹Excludes tallow that contains more than 0.15% insoluble impurities

²Tallow is defined by 21 CFR 589.2001(b)(5) as the rendered fat of cattle. Tallow that contains more than 0.15% insoluble impurities is considered to be an animal protein prohibited in ruminant feed in 21 CFR 589.2001(a)(1). Such tallow should be labeled with the cautionary statement, "Do not Feed to Cattle or Other Ruminants."
