Notice 24-04 TermiTek Termite Monitoring Only Product

To: All Georgia Structural Pest Control Licensees From: Georgia Structural Pest Control Commission Subject: TermiTek Decision Date: 05/15/2024

This notice is to provide clarification of the use of the TermiTek termite detection product under the Rules of the Georgia Structural Pest Control Commission.

The Rules of the Georgia Structural Pest Control Commission and the Georgia Structural Pest Control Act require a pest control license in the category of wood-destroying organisms to provide termite control protection in structures. The Rules also require minimum control standards for the prevention and control of subterranean termites in structures. Rule 620-6-.02 WDO Contracts, requires a written contract including a minimum adequate control measure as defined in 620-6-.04. The Contract Rule also requires reports of all monitoring and/or inspections of the structure(s), termite baiting systems and devices. Termite baiting systems are required to be registered by U.S. EPA.

To use the TermiTek monitoring only product, these requirements must be met.

Under Rule 620-6-.02(4) Subterranean termite control warranty only contracts are permitted without an initial treatment. These contracts do require a type of minimum termite control treatment to be specified on the contract and performed with the occurrence of termite activity. This type of contract may not be issued in place of a pre-construction treatment for subterranean termite control and limited to one- and two-family dwellings and townhomes.

Refer to the Rules of the Georgia Structural Pest Control Act, Chapter 620-6 for all of the requirements for minimum termite control treatment standards.
