Anyone who intends to grow hemp in the State of Georgia must successfully complete the full application process with the GDA and be issued a Hemp Grower License prior to receiving, producing, cultivating, handling, or storing hemp plants or seeds.

**Check All That Apply for Grower**

- I intend to process the hemp that I grow. (requires a Hemp Processor Permit).
- I intend to enter into an agreement with an approved Georgia Permittee to process the hemp that I grow.

*A Hemp Grower License does not allow the Licensee to process hemp. A Hemp Processor Permit is required for the processing of hemp plants. Licensed Hemp Growers who intend to process hemp must apply separately for a Hemp Processor Permit.*

*As a reminder, "hemp" means the plant species Cannabis sativa L. and any part of that plant, including the seeds thereof and all derivatives, extracts, cannabinoids, isomers, acids, salts, and salts of isomers, whether growing or not, with a total THC concentration of not more than 0.3 percent. The Hemp Grower License does not give you the ability to grow or handle cannabis materials with a total THC concentration greater than 0.3 percent.*

 **Processor**

Anyone who intends to process hemp in the State of Georgia must successfully complete the full application process with the GDA and be issued a Hemp Processing Permit prior to taking possession of or processing hemp.

**Check All That Apply for Processor**

- I intend to receive and process hemp from a Georgia licensed hemp grower.
- I intend to receive and process hemp from an out-of-state grower who is authorized to produce hemp under a State or Tribal hemp plan approved by the USDA, under a hemp license issued by USDA, or under 7 U.S.C. 5940.
- I intend to become a Georgia licensed hemp grower and process the hemp that I grow.

*A Hemp Processor Permit does not allow the Permittee to cultivate, farm, or produce living clones of hemp. A Hemp Grower License is required for the cultivation or production of hemp plants. Processors who intend to grow hemp must apply separately for a Hemp Growers License.*

*A Hemp Processor Permit only gives you the ability to process and handle hemp. As a reminder, "hemp" means the plant species Cannabis sativa L. and any part of that plant, including the seeds thereof and all derivatives, extracts, cannabinoids, isomers, acids, salts, and salts of isomers, whether growing or not, with a total THC concentration of not more than 0.3 percent. The Hemp Processor Permit does not give you the ability to process or handle materials with a total THC concentration greater than 0.3 percent. GDA will only issue Hemp Processor Permits for processing facilities. GDA will not issue permits to applicants who only intend to operate retail outlets.*

Georgia hemp grower license applicants must provide information on each grow site and storage site where they intend to cultivate, handle, and store hemp. Each site must be reported separately below. See the below description for requirements for each property site type.

**Grow Site Property:** Georgia hemp grower license applicants must provide a legal description of each grow site, whether the grow site is a field or a covered growing facility. Hemp growers must attest that they have legal authority to grow hemp at the site, such as holding the deed, a leasehold, or a license to the property. Latitude and longitude must be provided along with an aerial map or photograph (satellite imagery) that clearly shows the boundaries and dimensions of each grow site (field or covered growing facility).

**Storage Site Property:** Georgia hemp grower license applicants must provide a legal description for each storage site property along with copies of relevant easements or licenses as proof of legal authority to cultivate hemp on the site. Latitude and Longitude must be provided along with an aerial map or photograph (satellite imagery) that clearly shows the boundaries and dimensions of each storage site.

It is also your responsibility to report your crop to your local USDA Farm Services Agency. Your hemp crop must be reported after planting and before July 15 of each growing year. [USDA Service Center Locator](#)

As the licensee, we recommend you contact your Georgia county extension office and county Sheriff's Office to report you are a licensed Georgia hemp grower and to report all growing, drying, and processing sites.

Hemp must not be cultivated, handled, harvested, or stored in any location that is not listed in the hemp grower license application unless amended in advance.

Georgia Hemp Grower License applicants must provide information on each grow site and storage site (property if you intend to store/handle/dry hemp). Each individual property must be reported separately below. See the description for requirements for each property site type.

\* The term "handler" is defined in part as "to possess or store hemp plants for any period of time on a grow site, or controlled by a person licensed to cultivate or process hemp" (40-50-1-.02). Handling includes hemp plants after harvest. Hemp Growers may have two options for drying hemp: 1) dry hemp inside or 2) outside the plants.

**Grow Site Property:** Georgia Hemp Grower License applicants must provide a legal description, whether it is a field or a covered growing facility, along with copies of relevant easements or licenses as proof of legal authority to cultivate hemp on the site. Latitude and Longitude must be provided along with an aerial map or photograph (satellite imagery) that clearly shows the boundaries and dimensions of each grow site (field or covered growing facility).

**Storage Site Property:** Georgia Hemp Grower License applicants must provide a legal description for each storage site (property) along with copies of relevant easements or licenses as proof of legal authority to cultivate hemp on the site. Latitude and Longitude must be provided along with an aerial map or photograph (satellite imagery) that clearly shows the boundaries and dimensions of each storage site.

As the licensee, we recommend you contact your Georgia county extension offices and county Sheriff's offices to report you are licensed and report all growing, drying, and processing sites. If you do not know your local sheriff, we suggest a web search on your county name add the word "sheriff" to locate your county office. For example: "Fulton County Sheriff".

**Storage Site Property:** Georgia Hemp Grower License applicants must provide a legal description for each storage site property along with copies of relevant easements or licenses as proof of legal authority to cultivate hemp on the site. Latitude and Longitude must be provided along with an aerial map or photograph (satellite imagery) that clearly shows the boundaries and dimensions of each storage site.

It is also your responsibility to report your crop to your local USDA Farm Services Agency. Your hemp crop must be reported after planting and before July 15 of each growing year. [USDA Service Center Locator](#)

### HEMP GROWER LICENSE APPLICATION GUIDELINES

- The Georgia Department of Agriculture (GDA) administers the Georgia Hemp Farming Act as authorized by O.C.G.A. § 2-23-1, et seq.
- This Hemp Grower License Application is designed to provide sufficient instructions for completion by any individual who would be prepared to participate in the Georgia Hemp Program. The application includes a broad understanding of the program, but applicants should read the Georgia Hemp Farming Act (O.C.G.A. § 2-23-1, et seq.), the Hemp Definitions & Grower Rules (Ga. Comp. R. & Regs. R. 40-32-1 & 2, et seq.), and the USDA Interim Rule (7 CFR 990, et seq.).
- Please make sure to fully review all application materials and Grower License Rules prior to contacting hemp program staff with questions. GDA is not in a position to offer direct consultation on completing a Hemp Grower License application or to educate individuals about the production of hemp.
- Anyone who intends to grow hemp in the State of Georgia must successfully complete the full application process with the GDA and be issued a Hemp Grower License prior to receiving, producing, cultivating, handling, or storing hemp plants or seeds. Receiving, producing, cultivating, handling, or storing hemp plants or seeds prior to full completion of the licensing process may result in the denial of your application.
- A Hemp Grower License does not allow the Licensee to process hemp. A Hemp Processor Permit is required for the processing of hemp plants. Licensed Hemp Growers who intend to process hemp must apply separately for a Hemp Processor Permit.
- Renewal applications, annual license fees, and annual criminal background checks must be submitted by December 1 of the year issued. Licenses will expire on December 31 of the year issued if the renewal application, renewal fee, and background checks are not timely submitted.
- The Annual Hemp Grower License fee is \$50.00 per acre intended to be cultivated (up to a maximum fee of \$5,000.00) annually.
- Georgia Hemp Grower License applicants must own or have legal permission to cultivate, handle, or store hemp on the property listed on their application. A deed or lease will be sufficient in most cases.
- Georgia Hemp Grower Licensees may not cultivate in a building or structure used for residential purposes.
- Background checks are required for each owner, key participant, and person holding a beneficial interest in the Hemp Grower License. Key participants include a partner in partnership, or a person with executive managerial control in a corporation (e.g. CEO, COO, CFO, etc.). Background checks must be received and reviewed by GDA prior to issuance of a Hemp Grower License.
- Each Licensee must have a Department-approved sampling agent collect samples from the flower material of each lot of cannabis plants for delta-9 tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) concentration level testing within 30 days of the anticipated harvest. The Licensee must not harvest any cannabis prior to samples being taken. The Licensee must then harvest the crop not more than 30 days following the date of sample collection.
- All costs associated with the production of hemp are the responsibility of the Licensee including, but not limited to, costs for sampling and testing of hemp plants.
- No person will be issued more than one Hemp Grower License, nor will any person be permitted to have a beneficial interest in more than one Hemp Grower License.
- Hemp Grower Licenses cannot be sold, assigned, transferred, pledged, or otherwise disposed of, alienated, or encumbered to or by another person, business, individual, or entity.
- Hemp must not be cultivated, handled, harvested, or stored in any location that is not listed in the Hemp Grower License Application.
